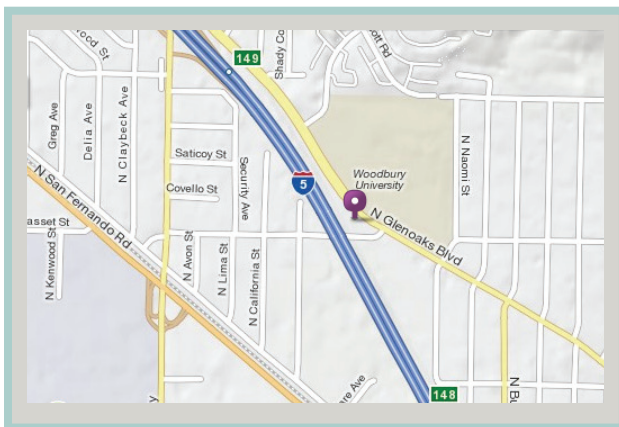

Are your Heat Illness procedures updated and ready?

Heat illness can be deadly. Maintaining heat safety awareness at your jobsite can protect your employees and help prevent costly fines and loss of business. That is why it is important to incorporate heat illness prevention procedures into your safety plan.

Recently, there have been significant changes to Cal/OSHA's Heat Illness Prevention Standard that can impact your operations.

State Fund and Cal/OSHA invite owners, supervisors, and trainers who are responsible for employee training to learn how Cal/OSHA interprets and enforces the **revised standard** as it applies to:

- Access to Water
- Access to Shade
- Written Procedures
- Employee/Supervisor Training
- High-heat environments

These seminars will feature a speaker from Cal/OSHA Consultation Service. Cal/OSHA speakers will also provide an update on **AB2774**, which redefines the term "**serious violation**" and reforms the manner in which Cal/OSHA establishes such violations.

Note: Cal/OSHA and the Division of Labor Standards Enforcement (DLSE) will provide continuing education credit to attendees, which may be applied towards the Farm Labor Contractor license training requirements.
